Who was
Charles Todd
Quintard?

Charles Todd Quintard was the second Bishop of Tennessee, a medical doctor, and a defender of slavery who himself owned enslaved people.

Quintard, a native of Connecticut, served as chaplain to the Confederate Army of Tennessee during the Civil War.

After the Civil War, Bishop Quintard was named Vice-Chancellor of the University of the South, where he traveled across the country and to England to raise funds from Confederate Sympathizers for a southern university.

Bishop Quintard was integral to the establishment of the School of Theology, the funds for which he secured from unrepentant Confederate émigré, Charlotte Manigault.

Bishop Quintard was a leader of post-war efforts to reunify the Episcopal Church.
